

**"Farms, Food & FUN!"
LESSON PLAN SEVEN**

Accompanying Song from CD: "Don't Frown, Slow Down,"

Activity: Reading Body Language

Skills: Kids can use their faces and bodies to display body language.

Grade Level: Kindergarten through third grade

Objectives: Discuss the importance of smiles, frowns and body language and how others are affected by this.

Time Required: 15 minutes.

Group size: Classroom or smaller groups, if preferred.

Materials Needed: CD player and lots of room to move!

Procedure: Find an area where desks, nor chairs, are in the way and turn on the CD player. Show over-emphasized frowns and smiles. And pull on the reigns to show "slow down." Ride up and down on the school bus. Encourage laughter and fun through animation!

Evaluation: Ask the children if they know why it's important to be safe on the road? Why are there speed limits? Why are there blinking lights, etc.
